2020 Guidelines:

- Participation is completely voluntary.
- Participants may work in teams of up to 4 students. K-2 students may work with a parent or other adult.
- Each team will submit a completed project form (below) by January 22nd.
- Participants will do their projects on their own time (not in class).
- A tri-panel board will be provided to each participant/team to display their work.


